

Activity: Wowe A:wank'okshi (Farm animals)

What they need to know: I can identify farm animals and name farm animals

What do they have to do: I can name and describe farm animals

Materials: Paper, Pencil/marker

Directions: Ask your child/children to describe the pig in Zuni. Write down their responses on a paper. Try to only speak in Zuni as much as you can. If you do not speak Zuni you can ask other family members or Zuni friends to help. If child does not understand what you are asking them, you can point to the picture as you are asking the question. Here is an example.

English: what is this?

Zuni translation: Kwa'p lukkya? (pointing to the pig)

If they answer pig in English. You would translate in Zuni- bitsu:di

Repeat word and have the child/children repeat with you three times.

Bitsu:di, bitsu:di, bitsu:di

Here are some questions you can ask?

What is the size of the pigs tail? long or short?

What color is the pig?

How many legs does the pig have?

What is the size of the pig? Big? Small

Check for Understanding: Repeat questions that were asked.

Extended Activity: Have children draw a similar picture and tell about their picture. Or find another picture of the same animal with different size, color, etc.
