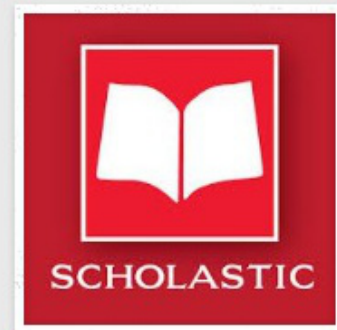


READING A-Z

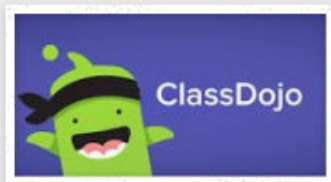


SEESAW
