<p>Language Arts (Ms. Desa)</p>	<p>Open Court Reading: We will start our unit “Keep Trying”. This week we will read various books that focus on end punctuation. We will practice editing ending sentence punctuation the in different sentences.</p> <p>Novel Study: Our novel study will be “Dragon Masters: Rise of the Earth Dragon”. This conclude our novel study and start our culminating activity. We will be designing our very own dragons, using the different external features we’ve learned in science.
