Grade 2 Ms. Murphy

Language Arts (Ms. Murphy)	This week students will be continuing on different forms of creative writing. Students will progress through booklets geared towards sparking their creativity in writing. Students will work on homophones and a number of reading comprehension strategies. We will have our spelling test on Friday this week.
Math (Ms. Murphy)	Students will be finishing up Chance and Data on Friday. We will be learning about probability, likelihoods and predictions. There will be no math test this week.
Physical Education (Coach Henderson)	Students will focus on low organized games, drills and exercises throughout the month of May.
Art (Ms. Murphy)	This week in Art, we will be discussing George Seurat and his concept of pointillism. We will be working on a project around this concept for a few weeks.
Music (Mr. K)	The students will be introduced to chromatic percussion instruments. They will differentiate between chromatic and non-chromatic instruments. They will continue to practice the songs <i>Goodbye My Friend</i> , <i>Into the Woods Finale</i> , and the opening to <i>Part IX</i> of the play.
French (Mr. Rodayan)	Students will review sight words and common expressions to help build on their understanding of French conversation prompts. They will continue with their vocabulary words to prepare for a “dictée” this week.
Social Studies (Ms. Murphy)	In our Global Communities unit, students will be learning about climate and representing different climates and temperatures on the world.
Science (Ms. Murphy)	In our Air and Water in the Environment unit, we will be learning about pollution and how we affect air and water. They will be creating posters to showcase their understanding of pollution.
Health (Ms. Murphy)	We will be focusing on growth mindset this week in health.
Computers (Ms. Murphy)	This week in computers, the students will be starting a unit on Google Earth. The students will be working on this for two weeks and looking up different areas around the world.
