<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>This month's language arts theme is Mythology. Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. We will be continuing with our cursive letters this week. Spelling words will go home on Monday, this will be the last week that we will have spelling before the break.</p>

We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be a math test on Friday consolidating their knowledge from the week. .</p>
<p>Science (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>Students will continue discussing our second topic this term, ' Structures.' We will be learning about human and animal built structures. Due to the Christmas Concert rehearsal, we will be missing two science classes this week.</p>
<p>Social Studies (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>There will be no social studies this week due to Christmas Concert rehearsals.</p>
