## February 11th - 15th

Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)	This month's language arts theme is <b>Biographies</b> . Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. We will be exploring different biographies and looking at similar features they have. We will be continuing with our cursive letters this week. Spelling words will go home on Monday.
Math (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 86-89. Students will be learning about the area of a rectangle as well as finding sums using 3 addends. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be a math test on Friday consolidating their knowledge from the past week.
