

## Grade 3 Mrs. Adamson

## October 15th - 19th

Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)	This month's language arts theme is <b>Mythology</b> . Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. Students will continue to work through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>The Twits</u> by Roald Dahl. We will begin reading chapter 5 of our in class novel, <u>Zeus and the Thunderbolt of Doom.</u> We will be continuing with our cursive letters this week. New spelling words will be sent home weekly every Monday.
Math (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 27-31. In these lessons we will be looking at reading and writing numbers to 1000, writing money and rounding to the nearest 2 degrees on a thermometer. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be a math test consolidating knowledge from lessons 26-30 on Thursday October 18th.
Science (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will continue to work on the unit 'Forces and Movement.' We will be taking a look at forces in our daily lives, forces of nature and safety devices.
Social Studies (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will continuing working on 'Communities in Canada 1780-1850.' This week we will be creating a drama skit in order to better understand the differences between the Wendat and Annishinaabe groups.
French (Mme. Israil)	With grade 3 this week students will continue learning "ER/ger" verbs (manger - changer - partager). We will continue with our Halloween vocabulary. This week focus will be on writing and oral skills.

Music (Mr. Kudera)	The students will continue to practice their <i>White Belt</i> training in Recorder Karate on Wednesday. On Thursday, they will practice writing notes on the treble clef. They will also practice the song <i>A Wish for Peace</i> for the Remembrance Day ceremony.
Media Arts (Mrs. Grovum)	Our theme this week is "catalogue searching". Students will receive their Destiny account login information and will review how to search the online catalogue.
Visual Art (Ms. James)	This week, each student will continue working on their final <b>POP</b> Art Project in class.
Computers (Mr. Kudera)	The students will continue to learn about the parts of a computer and their functions. This week they will focus on <i>input</i> devices.
Drama (Mrs. Massaro)	Students will be introduced to some new reader's theatre pieces which they will then be assessed on.
Physical Education (Coach Fretz)	Students will be taking part in soccer skills and games this week. Students will also take part in the beep test and cooperative games to earn points for their House (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).
