

Grade 3 Mrs. Adamson

September 10th - 14th

Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)	This month's language arts theme is Mythology. Students will begin this week by writing a journal about a few of the most exciting events of their summers. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. Students will begin working through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>Harry Potter & The Philosopher's Stone</u> , by J.K. Rowling. We will begin our first unit of spelling which will focus on words with a short 'a' and 'o' sound.
Math (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 5-8. In these lessons we will be looking at commutative property of addition, estimating length to the nearest inch, identifying properties of rectangles and ordering two digit numbers. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday.
Science (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will continue to work on the unit 'Forces and Movement.' We will be focusing on Friction this week and how to use newton scales.
Social Studies (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will be introduced to their first topic of the term 'Communities in Canada 1780-1850.' We will be looking at timelines and dates this week as well as subtopics.
French (Ms. Israil)	This week will review 'ER' verbs. Students will be given worksheets for to individual work. We will also be Reviewing scholar vocabulary.

Music (Mr. Kudera)	The students will learn how to play G and A on their recorders. They will also start practicing the song <i>Count on Me</i> .
Media Arts (Mrs. Grovum)	Students will learn about book return procedures and will explore books related to Dot Day!
Visual Art (Ms. James)	This week, students will be introduced to brief history of Pop Art and learn about a few famous artists. Students will continue to practice different techniques and examples.
Computers (Mr. Kudera)	The students will practice locating various keys on the QWERTY keyboard. They will also practice logging into their personal accounts.
Drama (Mrs. Massaro)	Students will play drama games to help them get comfortable using expression and movement, and help them move out of their comfort zone.
Physical Education (Coach Fretz)	Students will be taking part in team activities and leadership building games. They will also be introduced to the cross country sports event and will have the opportunity to train for this event.
