<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>This month's language arts theme is Mythology. Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. Students will continue to work through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>The Twits</u> by Roald Dahl. We will begin reading chapter 1 of our in class novel, <u>Zeus and the Thunderbolt of Doom</u>. This week, we will begin learning cursive. Our spelling unit this week will focus on short e,i and u sounds.</p> <p>Words: else, buzz, finish, head, summer, lift, ready, visit, fence, live.</p>
<p>Math (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 10-14. In these lessons we will be looking at subtraction facts, writing number sentences, dividing squares, congruent shapes, counting dimes and nickels, and adding two digit numbers using mental math. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be a math test consolidating knowledge from lesson 1-10 on Tuesday September 18th.</p>
<p>Science (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>Students will continue to work on the unit 'Forces and Movement.' We will be looking closer at magnets, forces, and friction.</p>
<p>Social Studies (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>Students will be introduced to their first topic of the term 'Communities in Canada 1780-1850.' We will be looking at subtopics with a focus on the questions we created the previous lesson.</p>
<p>French (Ms. Israil)</p>	<p>This week students continue learning vocabulary and review "ER" verbs. Grade 3 will also be introduced to verb "etre" and "avoir" .</p>

<p>Music (Mr. Kudera)</p>	<p>The students will learn to play “B” on their recorders. They will also continue to practice the song Count On Me for the upcoming Grandparents’ Day assembly.</p>
<p>Media Arts (Mrs. Grovum)</p>	<p>Our theme this week in Media Arts is Mindfulness. Students will explore the theme in books and in the MakerSpace.</p>
<p>Visual Art (Ms. James)</p>	<p>We will spend this week finishing up our Pop art inspired labels as well as discussing different types of lines. We will conclude the class by brainstorming ideas for your independent Pop Art Project.</p>
<p>Computers (Mr. Kudera)</p>	<p>The students begin their keyboarding exercises. They will also practice logging into their personal accounts.</p>
<p>Drama (Mrs. Massaro)</p>	<p>Students will begin acting out scenes from picture books.</p>
<p>Physical Education (Coach Fretz)</p>	<p>Students will be taking part in soccer skills this week. They will also be training for cross country and taking part in various cooperative games. Each Friday students will take part in active and cooperative games to earn points for their House (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).</p>
