<b>Language Arts</b> (Mrs. Adamson)	This month's language arts theme is <b>Graphic Novels</b> . Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. They will be working on Grammar, reading comprehension and correct the Sentence. Students will continue to work through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>The Twits</u> by Roald Dahl. We will be exploring different Graphic Novels and looking at special features. We will be continuing with our cursive letters this week. Spelling words will go home on Monday.
<b>Math</b> (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 66-69. In these lessons we will be looking at missing addends, subtracting 2 digit numbers, writing numbers to 1,000 in words, and multiples of 100. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be a math test on Friday consolidating their knowledge from the week.
<b>Science</b> (Mrs. Adamson)	Students will continue discussing our second topic this term, 'Structures.' We will continue building our structures from lego as well as beginning our final research project on a structure of choice.
<b>Social Studies</b> (Mrs. Adamson)	This week we will be discussing Settlers Villages and how they have evolved and stayed the same since 1850.
<b>French</b> (Mrs. Grovum)	Students will begin the new term with a unit on physical attributes and adjectives.
<b>Music</b> (Mr. Kudera)	Reviewing recorder technique (staccato vs. legato) pages 5 and 6 in Recorder Karate

<b>Media Arts</b> (Mrs. Grovum)	Students will begin their unit of Authors & Illustrators with books from Mo Willems! They will complete activities based on his works.
<b>Visual Art</b> (Ms. James)	This week students will be introduced to our new unit, Pointillism. We will be discussing this art movement and then completing an activity to practice the new technique.
<b>Computers</b> (Mr. Kudera)	Review login procedures, embedding and manipulating graphics into Google Docs.
<b>Drama</b> (Ms. Weston)	We will continue working on our Shakespeare play.
<b>Physical Education</b> (Coach Fretz)	Students will be taking part in modified volleyball skills this week. They will continue to participate in a game called "bound ball" to learn proper foot movement and positioning. Students will also take part in cooperative games to earn points for their House (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).
<b>Health</b> (Mr. Fretz)	Students will begin their new unit this week. Throughout this unit they will identify the impact of use of legal/illegal substances and explore decision making in relation to substance use and personal behaviours in the Substance Use unit. This week they will begin by discussing known legal substances.
