<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>This month's language arts theme is Mythology. Students will begin this week by writing a journal using a teacher provided prompt to guide them. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>The Twits</u> by Roald Dahl. We will read chapter 7 of <u>Zeus and the Thunderbolt of Doom</u>, followed by comprehension questions. We will be continuing with our cursive letters this week. Spelling words will go home Tuesday this week as Monday is a holiday.</p>
<p>Math (Mrs. Adamson)</p>	<p>Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 41-44. In these lessons we will be looking at place value, mental computation, naming line segments, identifying missing digits in problems and factors. We will continue to work on prodigy during our math lab on Thursday. There will be no math test this week.</p>
