<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be continuing with our <b>Fiction</b> theme this week. Reading, writing and grammar activities around this theme.</p> <p><i>Writing</i> Students will begin the week by writing a journal about the least scary monster in history. They will be working on SB Editing, Language Power Now, Correct the Sentence, Canada Writes and cursive writing. We will be doing short poems and other writing activities going along with our <b>Fiction</b> theme, specifically science fiction and historical fiction.</p> <p><i>Grammar</i> We will be looking at combining sentences in grammar this week.</p> <p><i>Reading</i> Students will be working on reading comprehension based on stories, articles and more read independently, in small groups, or as a class. These pieces will be focused around our <b>Fiction</b> theme. Students will begin working through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>Harry Potter &amp; The Philosopher's Stone</u>, by J.K. Rowling.</p> <p><i>Spelling</i> There are a number of spelling lists currently in circulation in order to give each child the best chance to succeed and be challenged in an appropriate way. If you would like me to send you your child's list and the "rule" that the words follow, please email me! <i>The spelling test will take place on Friday May 4 2018.</i></p>
<p>Math (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 116-119.
