

Mr. Kudera's Weekly Outline: May 22 to 25

Music

Grade One

The students will watch a variety of movie clips and determine the type of music they think would be appropriate to go along with the clip. We will continue to practice the songs *Goodbye My Friend*, *Into the Woods Finale*, and *Steps of the Palace*.

Grade Two

The students will be introduced to chromatic percussion instruments. They will differentiate between chromatic and non-chromatic instruments. They will continue to practice the songs *Goodbye My Friend*, *Into the Woods Finale*, and the opening to *Part IX* of the play.

Grade Three

The students will continue to practice reading choral multi-part choral scores. They will learn about the four basic vocal ranges: soprano, alto, tenor, and bass. We will continue to practice the songs *Goodbye My Friend*, *Into the Woods Finale*, and *I Know Things Now*.

The students will be introduced to the *Romantic Era* of music. They will also practice the song *It Takes Two*.
