<p>Language (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>Spelling words: down, day, did, set, bus, truck, must, cup</p> <p>These words will be tested on Friday, March 29. I will no longer be sounding out each word, and instead will simply repeat the word several times as well as using it in a sentence.</p> <p>As always, there will be the option to try spelling 2 bonus words of my choice taken from last week's list of words.</p> <p>Writing: The students continue writing in their journals this week. They will be writing about what they did over the weekend. We will be focusing on using uppercase and lowercase letter appropriately and ensuring we have a period at the end of our sentences. Students will also start working in their explode the code book which looks at breaking down sounds of words and using different strategies in order to read words.</p> <p>Reading: As a class, we will be reading stories and reviewing the setting.</p> <p>Home Reading: Students are encouraged to read using Raz Kids as well as their library books and any other books sent home.</p>
<p>Math (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>Students will finish their unit on time.</p>
<p>Physical Education (Mr. Fretz)</p>	<p>Students will be taking part in jumping skills and verbal instruction tasks this week. On Friday the class will be taking part in activities to earn House Points for their designated house (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).</p>
