Language (Ms. Burghart)	<ul> <li>Spelling words: my, ant, first, water, bad, bat, glad, mad</li> <li>These words will be tested the week of February 19th. We will be focusing on using uppercase and lowercase letter appropriately and ensuring we have a period at the end of our sentences. Students will also start working in their explode the code book which looks at breaking down sounds of words and using different strategies in order to read words.
