



**November 19<sup>th</sup> - November 23<sup>rd</sup>**

<p><b>Language</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p><b>Spelling words: there, use, each, an, job, mob, cob, rob</b></p> <p>These words will be tested on Monday, November 26th. There will also be the option to try spelling 2 bonus words of my choice taken from last week's list of words.</p> <p><b>Writing:</b> The students continue writing in their journals this week. They will be writing about what they did over the weekend. We will be focusing on using uppercase and lowercase letter appropriately and ensuring we have a period at the end of our sentences. Students will also start working in their explode the code book which looks at breaking down sounds of words and using different strategies in order to read words.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> As a class, we will be reading stories and discussing the beginning, middle and end of the story.</p> <p><b>Home Reading:</b> Students will receive a book in their homework folders to read throughout the week. Students are also encouraged to read using Raz Kids.</p>
<p><b>Math</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>This week we will continue exploring 3D shapes by finding them in our environment. We are going on a shapes hunt!</p>
<p><b>Physical Education</b> (Mr. Fretz)</p>	<p>Students will be taking part in movement games and activities to build movement and instructional skills. They will be continuing directional running during activities and will be working to complete tasks based on verbal and visual instructions. On Friday the class will be taking part in activities to earn House Points for their designated house (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).</p>
<p><b>Art</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>This week in art we will continue to look at value and how each colour has different shades. We will be exploring different mediums to help explore this concept. We will be using language such as 'lighter' and 'darker'.</p>
<p><b>Music</b> (Ms. Murphy)</p>	<p>Our students will be working on instrument families. We will be continuing to discuss the string and percussion family this week. We will also be practicing our Christmas concert song of Deck the Halls.</p>

<b>French</b> (Mme. Israil)	This week students will continue reviewing the alphabet and will learn more words on letters I and J. Students will be assigned to complete some worksheets that have a letter and a word that involves coloring. SK students will keep learning some French expressions that are essential for a French Classroom. SKs will be introduced to months of the year.
<b>Science</b> (Ms. Burghart)	This week in science we will continue learning about energy around us.
<b>Health</b> (Mr. Fretz)	Students will begin their next unit on Personal Safety and Injury Prevention. They will continue with fire safety this week.
<b>Computers</b> (Ms. Burghart)	This week in Computers we will continue to practice using a mouse and discussing internet safety.
<b>Media Arts</b> (Ms. Desa)	Students will explore the differences in fiction and non-fiction literature.
<b>Drama</b> (Ms. Burghart)	For the next couple of weeks we will be finishing our unit on Dance by having students create a short dance routine with their classmates.
