<p><b>Language</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p><b>Spelling words: the, of, and, that, cat, mat, sat, hat.</b> These words will be tested on Monday, September 17th.</p> <p><b>Writing:</b> The students continue writing in their journals this week. They will be writing about what they did over the weekend. We will be focusing on using uppercase and lowercase letter appropriately and ensuring we have a period at the end of our sentences. Students will also start working in their explode the code book which looks at breaking down sounds of words and using different strategies in order to read words.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> As a class, we will be reading stories and listening for words that rhyme.</p> <p><b>Home Reading:</b> Students will receive a book in their homework folders to read throughout the week. Students are also encouraged to read using Raz Kids.</p>
<p><b>Math</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>This week we will be continue with identifying and writing numbers 1-100, as well as simple addition.</p>
<p><b>Physical Education</b> (Mr. Fretz)</p>	<p>Students will be taking part in movement games and activities to recognize spatial awareness. They will be focusing on running and directions during active games this week. On Friday the class will be taking part in activities to earn House Points for their designated house (Torrin, Malliag, Kyleakin).</p>
<p><b>Art</b> (Ms. Burghart)</p>	<p>This week in art we will be working on our 'name art' to help decorate our classroom. We will also discuss primary and secondary colours.</p>
<p><b>Music</b> (Ms. Murphy)</p>	<p>This week students will continue with songs and dance in our music class. We will be introducing the concept of rhythm to the students this week and we will become pattern makers to showcase our rhythm understanding through song and game.</p>
<p><b>French</b> (Mme. Israil)</p>	<p>This week SK students will review the alphabet, words and numbers. In our SK class we will be singing songs creating words and coloring.</p>

<b>Science</b> (Ms. Burghart)	This week in science we will continue our unit on structures and materials by asking ourselves the question “what can we do to make our playground better?”
<b>Health</b> (Mr. Fretz)	Students will continue their first unit on Healthy Eating this week. They will be introduced to our healthy super program and meet the “Super Heroes!” Students will be taking part in songs and activities to familiarize them with healthy snacks and the different food groups.
