A. <u>Understanding History</u>

- 1. Archaeologists examine objects to learn about past people and cultures.
- 2. Historians study the written records of human life and accomplishments to understand a society
- 3. Oral traditions can also help us learn about the past. Although not always accurate, they can tell us how people lived and what they considered important

B. <u>Linking Geography & History</u>

- 1. Historians use geography to help them understand why historic events took place
- 2. Weather Patterns, Growing Season,
 Water Supply, and Landscape can tell us
 why people lived in a place
- 3. Studying Climate & Location helps historians learn about why events happened and where they happened
- 4. Think Egypt: Because of its location on the Nile River, there was enough food to feed the large population.
