- 1. Dynasty to Dynasty
 - 1. Egypt had 31 Dynasties and three major periods called Kingdoms – Old, Middle, & New Kingdoms
 - 2. The times between the kingdoms were times of war
- 2. Egypt is unified
 - 1. The first dynasty began when a king named Menes united upper and lower Egypt
- 3. All-Powerful Pharaohs
 - 1. Pharaohs had complete control over their people
 - 2. Pharaohs were believed to be god-kings
- II. The Three Kingdoms
 - 1. Old Kingdom
 - 1. Peace and trade was kept with Nubia
 - 2. Most of the Pyramids were built during this kingdom
 - 2. Middle Kingdom
 - 1. Pharaohs spent nations wealth on public works instead of wars
 - 2. Money was spent on buildings and irrigation projects
 - 3. New Kingdom
 - **1.** Began in 1567^{B.C.}, had huge armies of foot soldiers, mounted warriors, and charioteers-nearly unbeatable
 - 2. King Tut was a popular Pharaoh during this kingdom and his treasures tell us a great deal about Egypt
- III. Rule During the New Kingdom
 - 1. The New kingdom had many powerful rulers King Tut, Queen Hatshepsut, and Thutmose III, and Cleopatra VII
 - 2. Toward the end of the New Kingdom, Egypt declined and civil war left it weak and poor
 - 3. Egypt fell to the famous conqueror Alexander the Great
 - 4. Cleopatra VII was the last pharaoh of Egpyt before it became part of the Roman Empire in 31_{B.C.}
