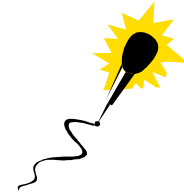

Early English Colonial Settlement *Radio Show*



Directions:

1. Your group is to develop and present a 3-4 minute radio program on your assigned topic. This program will take place at the end of your topic's time span and will look back on the history of the events.

Circle the topic your group is given:

- ❖ Roanoke
- ❖ Jamestown – up to (but not including) the “Starving Time”
- ❖ Jamestown – from the “Starving Time” to 1622
- ❖ Jamestown – 1606-1622

2. Your radio program should include:

- ❖ Background information on the topic
- ❖ Names/People
- ❖ Dates
- ❖ Places
- ❖ Events

3. The format of your radio program should be:

- ❖ A news report of the events, people, etc.
- ❖ A host introducing the topic and transitioning between parts of the story.
- ❖ Interviews with people
- ❖ Recordings of people talking, giving speeches, etc.
- ❖ Commentary by the reporters

4. After you have finished your required pieces to the radio program, your group may decide to add other parts to your radio program. Be creative.

5. The radio show will be performed for the class and those groups that meet the standard will have the opportunity to record their show.

6. Suggested Method:

- Talk about what you want to happen during the show
- List all of the important facts for your topic
- Decide who is going to cover each fact
- Divide up the script writing
