- 2. Google search "create a graph." It will be your first result.
- 3. Below are the items that need to be entered in empty fields and the steps to take, in order. Be sure to only enter items from the list below. Every other field should remain empty.

A. Select Bar Graph

B. Data Tab

Graph Title	Give the graph an appropriate title
X Axis Label:	Give the X axis an appropriate label
Y Axis Label:	Give the Y axis an appropriate label
Source:	Your first and last names
Data Set:	Items – Count your items. The items are the ethnic backgrounds in class.
	Values – those are the number of students of each ethnic background.
	Groups – set the value to 1
	Enter the ethnic backgrounds as Item Labels and their value as the
	number of people who share that ethnic background
	Bar Color – select one color OR select white if you want to do the extra
	credit, which is to draw the national flag as the bar color.

C. Labels Tab

This is formatting and can be skipped or adjusted if you have time. You should only change the font.

D. Preview Tab

You should preview your work and make any necessary changes.

E. Print/Save Tab
