A Massacre in Boston ~ Trial Simulation

## **ACTIVITY: Decide It**

5. Hold your jury deliberations focusing on the instructions and choices on the Jury Deliberation Sheet.

Jury Deliberation Sheet

Each jury member should deliberate over the guilt or innocence of Captain Thomas Preston and the soldiers and then vote on the possible verdicts. A unanimous verdict is required for these cases to be decided.

Captain Thomas Preston is accused of the crime of murder; 5 counts. Possible verdicts:

- 1. Innocent of both murder and manslaughter
- 2. Guilty of murder
- 3. Guilty of manslaughter

The eight soldiers are accused of the crime of murder; 5 counts. Possible verdicts:

- 4. All innocent of both murder and manslaughter
- 5. One or more guilty of murder; others innocent
- 6. One of more guilty of manslaughter; others innocent
- 7. One or more guilty of murder; one or more guilty of manslaughter; others innocent
- 3. Each jury should then report and be prepared to defend its verdict.
