



## **Great Compromise**

- Solves debate between large and small states
- Senate 2 per state
- House of Representatives based on population


## 3/5<sup>ths</sup> Compromise

- Placated the Southern states
- Counts enslaved men & women as 3/5 of a

person for state population







- Avoids a powerful central government
- 3 equal branches
  - 1. Legislative makes laws
  - 2. Executive enforces laws
  - 3. Judicial interprets laws

## Solutions to Confederation Problems

- 1. Each state has 1 vote in Congress, regardless of size
- 2. Congress no power to tax
- 3.No executive branch
- 4.No national court system
- 5. Amendments required a unanimous vote
- 6. States printed their own currency

- 5. 2/3 Congress & 3/4 of states
