In order to be considered for the Franklin Academy High School chapter of the Science National Honor Society, a candidate must meet specific requirements.

A <u>member</u> must be a Senior, Junior, or Sophomore:

- A member must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 grade point average.
- $\swarrow$  The member must also have a B+ (88.0% or 3.5 GPA) average in all science courses.
- A member must be enrolled in at least one honors or upper level science class during or prior to applying to the SNHS.
- All members are require to participate in the Science National Honors Society project.
- Member must attend at least 80% of the chapter meetings, activities, or events.
- Each member is required to participate in at least two tutoring session per quarter.
- To remain active, students must submit 20 verified hours of service each year. A minimum of 10 of these service hours must be completing service for SNHS.
- Maintain qualities of leadership and character.
- A student may be dismissed if he/she violates the standards, obligation, or ideals of the Science National Honors Society. This includes violation of grade, chapter projects, and/or behavioral requirements.

- $\boxed{100}$  Essay ~ Provide a word processed answer to the following questions.
  - Why do you want to be a member of SNHS? How do you intend to contribute to SNHS?
  - What do you think you will gain by your membership?
  - What science topic(s) would you like to explore in your research?

<u>Evaluation Procedure & Acceptance</u>: Your acceptance will be based on the quality of your essay, grades in science classes, character, and teacher evaluations. In addition, members of the SNHS Acceptance Committee will interview you to further judge your fit into the SNHS. As there are limited spaces each year, acceptance is not guaranteed.
