


2 syllable words rule:

Look at the middle of the word.

mitten

Does it have 2 consonants? YES

Split them-



read 1st syllable




then 2nd syllable



Then blend them to read the

word "mitten"



OPEN SYLLABLES rule:

Look at word



Make a vowel bridge



Is the 1 consonant between 2

vowels?

Split it between the 1st vowel

and consonant.


Yes! Then the 1st part is a long

vowel sound

Mark the open syllable with 'O'

Closed Syllables rule:

Look at word




Make a vowel bridge



Are the consonants between 2

vowels? mitten



Yes! Then split them between

the 2 consonants then read it

with a short vowel sound.

Mark closed syllable with "C"
