ESTIMATING CRASH FORCES

 Vertebral body compression 20-30 G Fracture/dislocation 20-40G Aorta intimal tear **50G** 80-100G Aorta transection 100-200G Pelvic fractures Vertebral body transection 200-300G Body fragmentation > 350G

The "Big Shot" @ the Stratosphere is 4Gs

- Aircraft travel @ high velocities & may crash to earth w/ extremely rapid deceleration forces
 - Not surprising to find body in several pieces
 - Challenge: Body ID

D OF VICTIMS

- Visual ID? Too severe of damage to ID
- Dental exam most useful in positive ID of body
 - When moving bodies, be sure to preserve dental remains
- FPs useful in noncharred bodies
- Other means of ID: X-ray comparison of bones, characteristic tattoos, any unique physical features... & of course DNA

DETERMINE/MANNER/OF/DEATH

- Although uncommon, the pilot may have been killed
- Homicide & insurance fraud may be attempted w/crash intended to hide the evid

Ex. A twin-engine personal plane rolled just after takeoff. Nose dived into the ground. The pilot was killed instantly.

Extensive damage to the front of the plane.

FALLS TO EARTH

STOWAWAYS: discovery of body w/severe BFT from where they fell/were stowed in the wheel-well region





FALLS TO EARTH

 PARACHUTE DEATHS: factors that lead to death include bad equipment, hazardous environmental conditions, inexperience, entanglement, power lines, & other objects



INVESTIGATION OF MASS DISASTERS

- Search & rescue to find all survivors
 - Searchers must be protected against potential hazards of scene
- Decontamination procedures enforced when return to staging area from scene
- ID remains & treat in a dignified fashion (regardless of size of body part) and placed in a regular-size coffin to send to the family



- Collect complete tox samples from pilot (TOXBOX)
- Be aware of many different ways to ID vics
- Seek help when disaster is more than your department can handle
- Consider crash may have been caused by natural disease of the pilot
- Collect pertinent info from the investigation performed by outside agencies



- Forget to x-ray hands & feet of pilot
- Exclude suicide or homicide until investigation is complete
- Panic in mass disasters
- Forget to consider the safety of all personnel involved in the investigation
- Ever fly or go skydiving again
