Rancho High School Capstone Project Requirements

As a student in Rancho High School's Magnet Academy, one of the requirements to receive your Magnet Certificate and Medallion is a "capstone project".

REQUIREMENTS

- Turn in to your senior magnet teacher on or before APRIL 3rd
 - If you are in multiple magnet classes, you only need to turn it into ONE teacher
- MUST BE **TYPED** and submitted in a folder
- Must contain the following, IN ORDER
 - 1. This signed form
 - 2. Resume
 - You completed one in 11th grade make sure to update it
 - 3. Volunteer Hours 40 hours TOTAL (minimum)
 - Of the 40 hours, 10 hours must be Medical Hours
 - Of the 40 hours, 10 hours must have been completed AFTER June 1, 2019
 - Keep a log of hours using "RHS Volunteer Log Sheet"
 - If your volunteer hours were done at Rancho, you do NOT need a letter from the advisor/teacher their signature on the Volunteer Log Sheet is sufficient
 - Obtain a letter from the company ON THE COMPANY'S LETTERHEAD stating
 - o that you DID volunteer with that company
 - o DATES/TIMES you were a volunteer
 - o explanation of your duties/tasks performed
 - 4. Reflection of Community Service and Medical Hours Summary Essay
 - What did you do during your community service?
 - What did you see?
 - How did you feel about it?
 - How did it align with your career goals?
 - Why do you think these hours are a requirement?

MINIMUM 2 pages, APA Format

(Times New Roman, 12-point font, 1" margins, double-spaced)

- 5. Copy of "Important" Tests Taken
 - SAT, **ACT**, ASVAB, AP Scores, etc...
- 6. Transcript
 - Print a copy of your transcript and HIGHLIGHT all of your Magnet, Science, Math, and English classes (MAGNET: Green, SCIENCE: Pink, MATH: Yellow, ENGLISH: Blue)
- 7. Copy of Certifications (even if expired)
 - CPR, First Aid, etc...
 - If you don't have any, you need to state that you don't have any

General APA Guidelines

Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. You should use a clear font that is highly readable. APA recommends using 12 pt. Times New Roman font.

Include a **page header** (also known as the "**running head**") at the top of every page. To create a **page header/running head**, insert page numbers flush right. Then type "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" in the header flush left using all capital letters. The **running head** is a shortened version of your paper's title and cannot exceed 50 characters including spacing and punctuation.

Major Paper Sections

Your essay should include four major sections: the Title Page, Abstract, Main Body, and References.

Title Page

The title page should contain the **title** of the paper, the **author's name**, and the **institutional affiliation**. Include the page header (described above) flush left with the page number flush right at the top of the page.

Abstract

Begin a new page. Your abstract page should already include the **page header** (described above). On the first line of the abstract page, center the word "Abstract" (no bold, formatting, italics, underlining, or quotation marks).

Beginning with the next line, write a concise summary of the key points of your research. (Do not indent.) Your abstract should contain at least your research topic, research questions, participants, methods, results, data analysis, and conclusions. You may also include possible implications of your research and future work you see connected with your findings. Your abstract should be a single paragraph, double-spaced. Your abstract should be between 150 and 250 words.
