

## MEME-ORIES: A COVID-19 Research Project

**Overview:** We are currently living through historic times. It isn't every day that the entire world gets shut down by a global pandemic! This is worth remembering, and what better way than utilizing the one thing that is keeping us all laughing while stuck at home? That's right – MEMES! Your task is to research the coronavirus that causes the COVID-19 disease and share your findings in a 10-slide digital project. To make this project a meme-ory you won't forget, you will be incorporating memes to illustrate your slides and bring humor during a time where we could all use a little laughter. While it is important to be creative and use your images to visually “com-meme-orate” this time, make sure that they are appropriate and that all information is accurate. This research project is meant to be both educational and hilarious!

### Requirements:

- All information is detailed, accurate, and written in the student's own words.
- Work is organized over 10 digital slides (*not including your works cited page*).
- All of the required components listed below are included and covered fully:
  - Description of what the coronavirus is and how it causes the disease COVID-19
  - Description of how the disease has become a pandemic, with reference to how viruses replicate
  - Description of the symptoms of COVID-19, highlighting how the disease disrupts homeostasis in the organ systems it most impacts
  - Relevant statistics about its prevalence and impact on society
  - Ways that the spread of COVID-19 can be prevented and treated, if acquired
  - Explanation of at least 3 misconceptions of the disease that have circulated through society via social media and scientifically accurate “debunking” of these myths
  - Description of what it is like in 2020 to live through this pandemic so that years from now someone who reads your project will have a clear picture of what was experienced
  - Predictions for the potential societal, economical, and historical impacts of this pandemic in the future
- Memes are creatively used to make connections to the content and make the project visually appealing, but must also be thoughtful, relevant, and appropriate.
- Project is colorful, neat, and fun. The organization of information is well thought out and clear.
- Research is appropriately cited and included on a separate formal citation page/slide.
- Overall project demonstrates accuracy, creativity, and a thorough understanding of the virus and disease.
