

## Las Personas en el Avión

This is a speaking assignment in a group. Decide who will play each role. Individually and as a group, work on what each person needs to say, and how to say it. Write key words as notes next to your role, and practice what you are going to say!

***NOTE:*** *You should become familiar with this role, as you will need to be able to speak it for the quiz!*

Weather: One person in each group may take turns at the computer to find out the weather at the departure city and the destination. ([www.weather.com](http://www.weather.com))

### The pilot

- Welcomes the passengers (bienvenidos a .....
- Says the number of the flight, the destination, and how long the flight lasts (dura)
- Says that s/he is the pilot.
- Says the weather at the destination

### The flight attendant

- Says that s/he is the flight attendant on flight # \_\_\_\_\_.
- Says that passengers can have 1 carry-on bag.
- Says the weather for the departure city.
- Says the departure time.

### The passenger

- Says that s/he is a passenger.
- Says where s/he is traveling to today.
- Says how many carry-on bags s/he has.
- Says where s/he is sitting (estoy en.....)

### The agent

- Says that s/he is the agent. (what type – ticket? Customs? Security?)
- Says what s/he does ( I check tickets, I check in luggage, I check passports, I inspect suitcases.....)
- Says what the passenger does at the counter (Al mostrador, .....talks to me, puts suitcase on scale, carries a passport, passes suitcases through security)
- Says if the flight is on time or has a delay. Says the boarding time and gate number.
