"Le" and "Les" may need to be clearer......

Le gusta leer.

- Could be
 - -He likes to read.
 - She likes to read
 - You (usted) likes to read.

"Le" and "Les" may need to be clearer.....

Les gusta leer.

- Could be
 - They like to read.
 - You (all) [ustedes] like to read.

How to make "le" or "les" clearer:

A ella le gusta leer.

(Clarifies that it is she.)

A ellos les gusta leer.

(Clarifies that it is they.)

A Juan le gusta leer.

(Clarifies that it is John).
