Objective

The objective of this class is to continue study of the Spanish language and the associated culture.

Topics

Topics covered this year include: review of greetings, classroom objects and subjects, time and calendar; body parts; travel and transportation; prepositions and directions; regular and irregular verbs in the present tense, initial work with the past tense (preterite); holidays, geography and culture of Spain. Reading for comprehension will include a chapter book in Spanish, about a Mexican youth's adventures while traveling with his family in Spain.

Grading Policy

Quizzes/Tests – quizzes weekly; tests weighted 2x	60%
Homework – due when assigned; no credit for lateness	20%
Class participation/ Daily "dictado" [translation work]	20%

- <u>Recommended online dictionary is *www.spanishdict.com*</u> Use of online language translators is restricted to single word lookup only. Obvious usage in homework and composition assignments will result in loss of grade points.

Students who are absent are responsible for getting the homework and turning it in the following day. (Student should use my web page or call a fellow student.) If a student is absent on the day of a <u>scheduled</u> quiz/test, the student will take it the next day s/he is in school.
