Instructions

1. Locate all places listed on back in an atlas and/or the map in a Spanish textbook (you may use one in my classroom), and write them NEATLY on your map in the following manner:

• Cities [Ciudades] (with <u>dots</u>) <u>Red</u> & Individual Islands [Islas]

Mountain Ranges [Cordilleras] Brown
Oceans & Rivers [Océanos y Ríos] Blue
Miscellaneous [Misceláneo] Purple

- 2. The country of **Spain** should be written (in Spanish) as the TITLE of your map.
- 3. Be sure to write all place names in Spanish, not as you see them in English in the atlas.
- **4.** All Autonomous Communities must be colored in with different colored **color pencils.**
- 5. Do **not** use thick markers or crayons. **Only** use colored pencils and thin-tipped pens/markers.
- **6.** Do **not** put anything extra on your map.

If, for some reason, you must TYPE your labels instead of writing them by hand, you <u>must</u> get approval from me <u>at the start of the project.</u>
