## Math

The kids were introduced to our new math program I-Ready. They took the I-Ready diagnostic placement test today. I will use this data to help me plan my lessons. I also introduced the kids to “Xtra Math.” This is an online math program designed to help them with their addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts. It’s adaptive and personalized. This is a great math option for their math log at home starting next week. We will begin our math lessons in I-Ready next week.

## Language Arts

Our CKLA unit 1 will launch next week. This unit focuses on personal narratives. The kids will be reading a variety of stories centered on this theme. They will also be writing their own narrative. For spelling, we will be working on “4<sup>th</sup> grade No Excuse words throughout the year. These words will be put in their planners each week. Mondays will be our spelling quiz/new words day. Early next week our focus will be on NWEA Map testing. The kids will be taking an assessment on both math and reading. DIEBLS testing will start soon too.
