Read 10-15 minutes and log time in your binder.

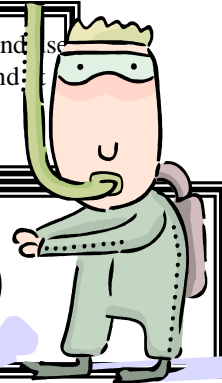
