Spelling Words: Please find your student's individual spelling list in his/her binder **Monday** Attached you will find the spelling homework options. **Spelling homework due Friday!**

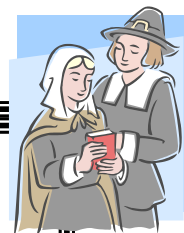
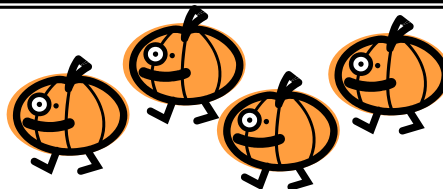
Next Unit of Study: Nations of the world, Colonial America, Pilgrims, Native Americans, & the Mayflower
