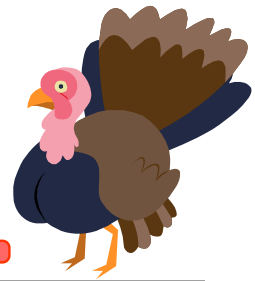

Wednesday

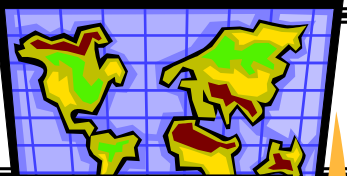
