

Parents are Partners Checklist

Check your child's RANGER Binder and folders everyday for mail or other class information.

Review your child's **math homework** and **reading response** each night. Have your child read their writing aloud to you and encourage corrections. (Ex. If it's not neat, have your child erase and repeat it). Spelling, grammar, and content are areas that students should check and correct to form strong daily writing habits. A C.U.P.S. sheet is provided in your child's response spiral.

Encourage daily reading & partner read books with your child to practice fluency and thinking deeper. Routinely ask questions to improve oral and written comprehension. (Comprehension questions can be found on our class website under "*Enrichment and Extra Practice.*")

Visit the public library or purchase books for your child to read and to meet the monthly AR Goal. (3 points is the minimum goal)

Check your email for our weekly "3rd Grade News You Can Use" message sent out each Monday to stay informed. *Our class webpage is an additional resource for helpful information.

Initiate more independence and responsibility with your child when completing homework or preparing their backpack for school.
