↳ is a symbolic representation of selected characteristics of a place, usually drawn on a flat surface.

↳ information about the world in a simple visual way.

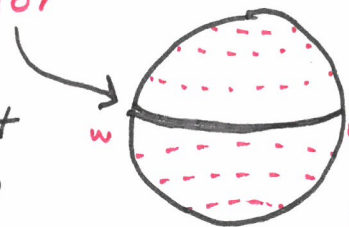
↳ come in all shapes & sizes

Latitude

↳ distance in degrees either North or South of the equator

equator

↳ an imaginary line that circles the \oplus \div it into 2 ~~parts~~ ^{earth} hemispheres.



Lines of Latitude is FATitude!

↳ Run EAST & WEST (see diagram)

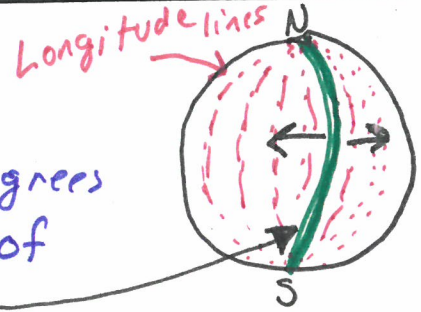

↳ refers to distance in degrees
either EAST ~ WEST of
the Prime Meridian
