HIS STORY BEGINS ... In the 1900's, a man by the name of Alfred Wegener, an accomplished meteorologist, believed, while he was lying in a hospital bed, that the Eastern coast of South America and the Western coast of Africa should fit together. A year later (1915) he published a book showing his evidence to support this "Theory of Continental Drift."

However; during this time the scientific community did not accept his ideas and he was rejected by his peers.
