
#### **Instructions to Login to Jupiter**


- 1. Go to <a href="https://login.jupitered.com/login/">https://login.jupitered.com/login/</a>.
- 2. Click on Student icon. Type in the student name/ID number. Then, type under school **Trinity Evangelical Lutheran School** issued to them.



**3.** Once they have login, they will be ask to reset the password. Please make sure that this is a password that you and your child can remember. Use their first name all lowercaps.

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
4. After that, you will be prompt to make changes to notifications.
