




# Hunting for Nouns, Verbs, Adjectives, and Adverbs

Students read the 10 sentences and decide which word in each sentence is the common noun, action verb, adjective, or adverb. They underline the words and then find them in the word search. The words can be found from left to right and from top to bottom. Only one word from each sentence is the correct answer. I encourage you to teach the children about the different types of nouns and verbs so they understand why some words may look like the right answer, but aren't. For example, students will not be finding proper nouns, pronouns, or linking verbs. Students can use the answer keys to check their own work.
