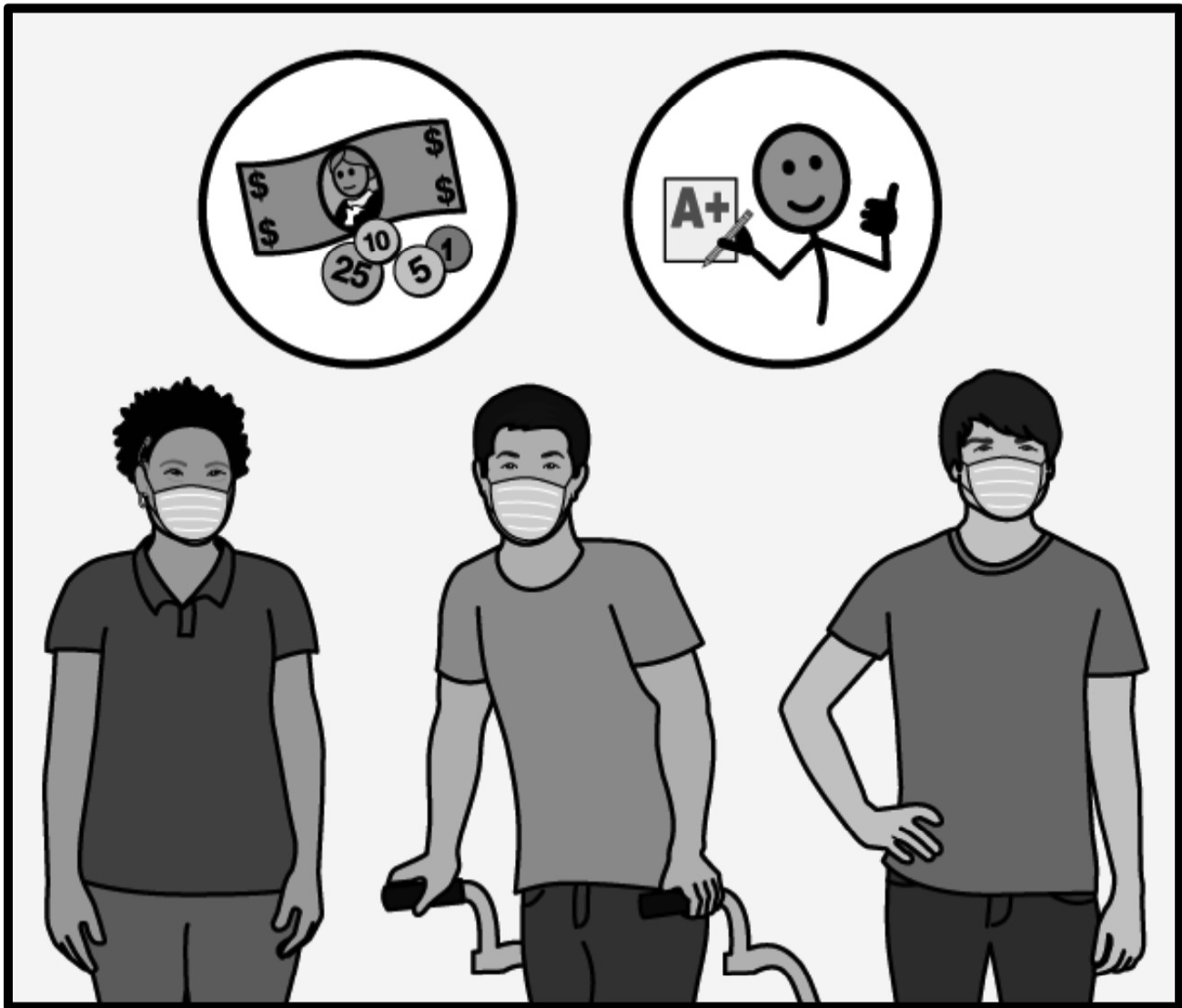

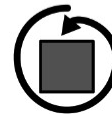

A plan for how to use money is called a budget.

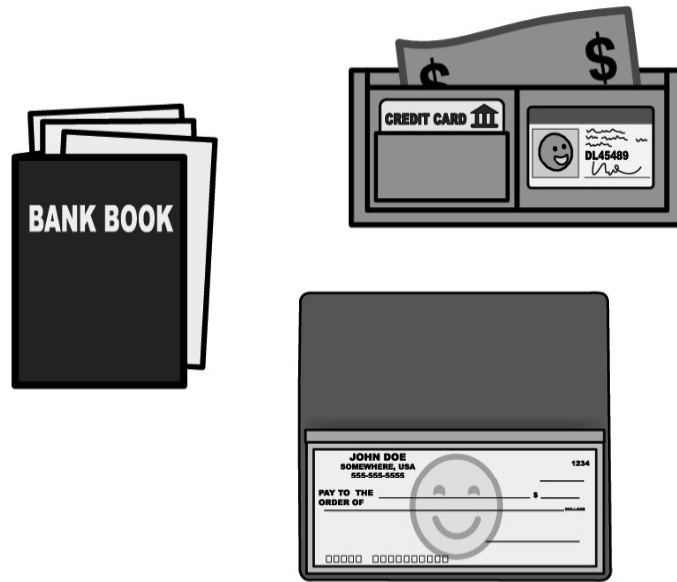

She needs to buy shorts for her job.

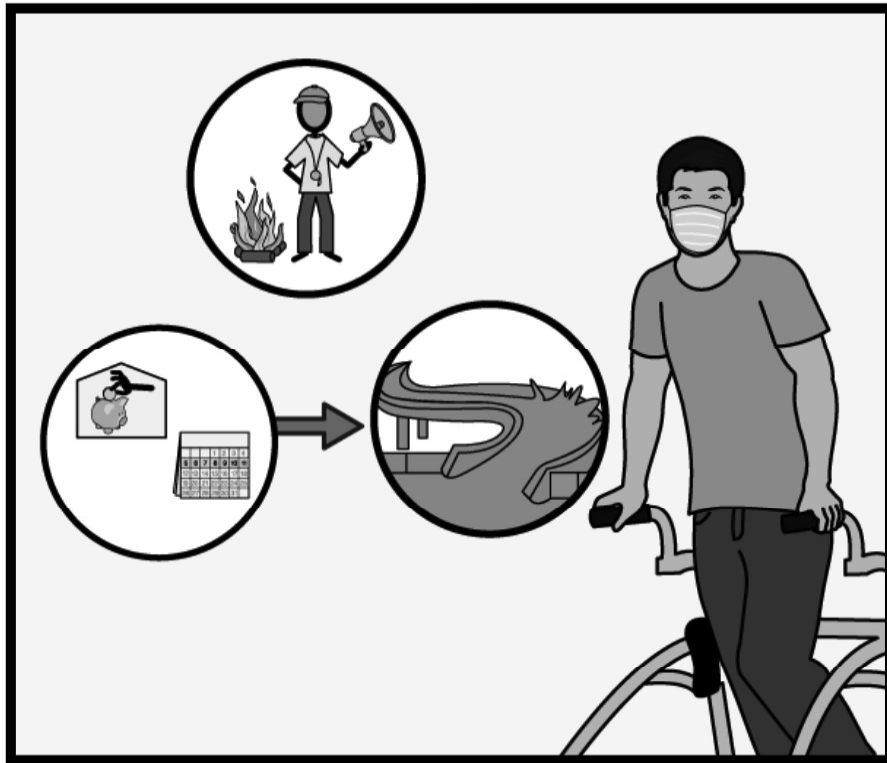


She will use money she has now to buy shorts.

He is saving to go to the water park.



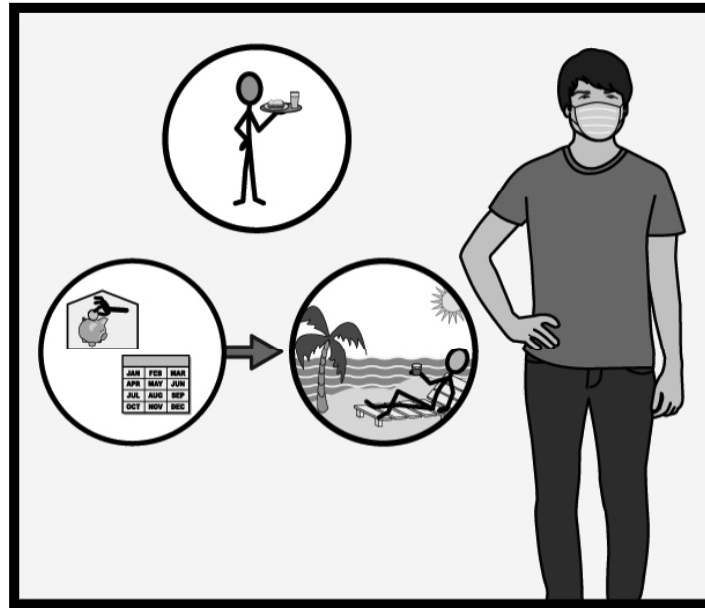
