They use flippers to swim through the water.














Sea turtles live in oceans.

Tour de Turtles tracks four kinds of sea turtles.











The kinds of sea turtles are:













hawksbill sea turtles,







and loggerhead sea turtles.



Scientists put trackers onto sea turtles before their migration.

Last year scientists tracked 21 sea turtles.

Satellites collect data from the trackers.











Scientists study the data.







The data shows the scientists where each sea turtle is.

















Trackers on sea turtles collect data.



Scientists can see where the sea turtles go.









They can see how fast the sea turtles move.













Scientists track the sea turtles for about three months.

Then the scientists announce which sea turtle went the farthest.






1. Spread frosting onto cupcake.



2. Put 10-12 green chocolate candies onto frosting in rows of 3 or 4 until cupcake is almost covered. Leave one empty space at front of cupcake.



3. Put one gummy candy onto frosting in empty space.



4. Put two small dots of chocolate frosting onto gummy candy for eyes.




5. Put two licorice pieces on each side of cupcake for flippers.
