

An auction is coming!

Approximately every 3 months room 19 has an auction. The auction will be on ______. Here is how the auction works:

- Students are able to spend their scholar dollars to purchase all auction items.
- Students can bring in items to "sell". Anything new or used will be accepted and will be sold at "fair market value". (I do not accept used pencils or pens).
- Students must get permission from their parents to sell items in the auction.
- Students may bring in handmade auction items. This includes edible items, duct taped wallets, pieces of art, handmade jewelry, etc. The maker of these items will receive all proceeds for selling that item. (Example a brownie is auctioned/sold for \$10.00 the maker of the brownie would receive the \$10.00).
- All new or used items and handmade items excluding edible items must be brought to school no later than the day before the auction.
- Edible items can be brought the day of the auction, but <u>must be</u> brought in by the tardy bell.
- If a student owes me money (IOU's) they may not participate in
 the auction until they are out of "debt". However, they may bring
 in items and all money made from those items will go towards
 paying off the debt. If they make more than they owe, they can
 then bid on items.
