He was Oklahoma's first native-born governor. He later served in the U.S. Senate, and helped create the Arkansas River Navigation system.

This was the toll road (highway) between Oklahoma City and Tulsa that began construction in the late 1940s.

She was an honor graduate of Langston University, and was the first African American admitted to the University of Oklahoma School of Law.

He was the son of a former governor, and during his tenure in office, the state government required all state employees to take a loyalty oath.

Under this governor, the Interstate highway system planned a series of three new super-highways to cross Oklahoma.

6. _____

This was an event where African-Americans entered public facilities and refused to leave until their demands were met.

She was a local Oklahoma City history teacher who demonstrated against segregation at the Katz Drug Store lunch counter.

8. _____

This Oklahoma Congressman served as Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives from 1971 to 1976.

9. _____

This Oklahoma astronaut was one of the first seven Americans in space under NASA's Project Mercury.

She was the first woman to complete NASA's screening process. Although she was a pilot, her gender excluded her from the spaceflight program.
