## 1. \_\_\_\_\_

This was the first Oklahoma tribe encountered by the expedition of Francisco Coronado. He described them as "a gentle people."

2. \_\_\_\_\_\_ This was the name for the tribal villages of the nomadic hunters and gatherers.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ These were dome-shaped huts made with tree branches and prairie grass.

4. \_\_\_\_\_\_ This Oklahoma tribe was discovered living in the Red River Valley. They used barter, meaning they traded surplus items for others of equal value.

5. \_\_\_\_\_\_ This was the most traded item, exchanged by farming tribes for meat from hunting tribes. Today it is called corn.

This was a tribe of Oklahoma farmers who were discovered by Hernando de Soto. Their Europeanstyle houses may have saved them from destruction.

This building technique consisted of sticks woven into a frame and then covered with mud.

8. \_\_\_\_\_ This is the Native American's name for their "god," to whom many tribes prayed each day. Some tribes called him "Sky Father."

9. \_\_\_\_\_\_Many Indians believed their lives were being guided by these land animals and birds, who also sent them visions in their dreams.

This was the title of the wise medicine man (or woman) who interpreted dreams and signs and used herbs and prayers to heal the sick.
