1. \_\_\_\_\_

When Louisiana became a state, the remaining region, which included Oklahoma, was given this name.

2. \_\_\_\_\_

In this conflict, the United States hoped to gain international respect by taking on the British. In the end, it would prove America's strength and character.

3. \_\_\_\_\_

He was the U.S. hero who defeated the British forces at the Battle of New Orleans in 1815.

4. \_\_\_\_\_

This tribe originally lived in Wyoming, but migrated to western Oklahoma due to clashes with the Sioux.

5. \_\_\_\_\_

This tribe, from Montana, also moved because of the Sioux. They settled in southwestern Oklahoma.

6. \_\_\_\_\_

This tribe migrated from the Ohio River Valley. They settled in Indian Territory to avoid further American expansion.

7. \_\_\_\_\_

This tribe originally held territory from Nebraska to Oklahoma. They warred with other tribes but were friendly to Americans.

8. \_\_\_\_\_

This was a very peaceful tribe, originally from Arkansas, who moved several times to avoid conflict. They eventually settled in northeastern Oklahoma.

9. \_\_\_\_\_

This was the first federal military establishment in Indian Territory. It was on the Grand River near Three Forks.

10. \_\_\_\_\_

This is a geographical term for the joining of rivers. Fort Towson was set up where the Kiamichi River flows into the Red River in southern Oklahoma.
