1. _____

This is a tax on imported or exported products. Governments use them to help products made in their own countries.

This is difference of opinion on how power should be divided between federal and local authorities.

3. _____

This 1850 law required citizens of all states to help recover runaways. It was passed in order to admit "free" California.

4. _____

These were people who believed slavery was wrong and worked to end it.

5. _____

This was a secret network of safe houses that helped slaves escape to Canada, where slavery was illegal.

6. _____

She wrote the novel Uncle Tom's Cabin, which dramatized the harsh realities of slavery. Some historians say it added to Northern efforts to end slavery.

7. _____

This was the right of people in the territories to decide the slavery issue for themselves. It was included in the Kansas-Nebraska Act.

8. _____

In this 1857 legal case, the Supreme Court ruled that Congress had no power to ban slavery anywhere in the United States.

9. _____

He was the Republican candidate who was elected president in 1860. Since he favored the end of slavery, the southern states broke away from the Union.

This was the full, formal name of the new country made up of 11 southern states that withdrew from the Union.
