The leaves of this plant are used to treat kidney and bladder infections, kidney stones, and diabetes.
2. \_\_\_\_\_  
The rootstock of this plant is used to treat rheumatism, sore throat, and respiratory infections.
3. \_\_\_\_\_  
The leaves of this plant are used to treat colds, flu, coughs, fevers, headache, and pain.
4. \_\_\_\_\_  
The inner bark, berries, and twigs of this plant are used in ointments, and to treat fever, pneumonia, and colds.
5. \_\_\_\_\_  
The leaves and flowering tops of this plant are used to treat backache, fever, inflammation, chills, and digestive problems.
6. \_\_\_\_\_  
The whole of this plant is used to treat a sore mouth.
7. \_\_\_\_\_  
The leaves of this plant are used to treat wounds.
8. \_\_\_\_\_  
The rootstock, roots, and seeds of this plant are used to treat asthma, respiratory ailments, and rheumatism.

The bark and leaves of this plant are used as an astringent, and to treat skin irritations, bruises, and varicose veins.

The leaves and flowering tops of this plant are used to treat indigestion, gastric pain, fevers, dysentery, and asthma.
