ABSENCES AND MAKE-UP WORK

STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE UP ALL WORK THAT WAS MISSED DUE TO A CLASS ABSENCE. STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE THE SAME AMOUNT OF TIME TO COMPLETE THE ASSIGNMENT AS THE STUDENTS WERE ALLOTTED AND ARE EXPECTED TO TURN IN THE ASSIGNMENT AT THE TIME SPECIFIED BY THE TEACHER. TESTS/QUIZZES/PROJECTS MUST BE MADE UP WITHIN A WEEK OF AN ABSENCE. STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO GO TO BAND LESSONS DURING A TEST/QUIZ/PROJECT PRESENTATION AND WILL ALSO NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO DURING A REVIEW SESSION IF THEIR GRADE IN THE CLASS IS BELOW A 70%. WHEN THE CLASS IS UTILIZING GOOGLE CLASSROOM, ABSENT STUDENTS WITH ACCESS TO WIFI AT HOME ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE OR TURN IN ASSIGNMENTS ONLINE.

TESTING

TESTING IS IMPORTANT IN THE SPANISH CLASSROOM TO DETERMINE A STUDENT'S GROWTH IN UNDERSTANDING OF GRAMMAR POINTS AND VOCABULARY AS WELL AS THEIR DEVELOPMENT IN LISTENING, READING, AND WRITING. ALL STUDENTS WITH TESTING ACCOMMODATIONS WILL RECEIVE THEIR APPROPRIATE MODIFICATIONS. ANY STUDENT WHO QUALIFIES TO HAVE A TEST READ TO THEM IS MORE THAN WELCOME TO SCHEDULE A TIME (WITHIN 3 DAYS OF TESTING) WITH THE TEACHER INSTEAD OF THE STUDENT SUPPORT CENTER OR SPECIAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SO AS TO RECEIVE CORRECT PRONUNCIATION OF SPANISH WORDS. CHEATING IS NOT TOLERATED IN THE SPANISH CLASSROOM. STUDENTS CAUGHT DOING SO WILL IMMEDIATELY RECEIVE A ZERO AS THEIR TEST SCORE.

TECHNOLOGY

TECHNOLOGY IS A WONDERFUL GIFT WHEN USED PROPERLY AND AT THE RIGHT TIMES. CELL PHONE USE DURING CLASS IS NOT APPRECIATED OR ALLOWED. IN ORDER TO SHOW RESPECT TO THE TEACHER AND THE LANGUAGE IT IS BEST TO SAVE CELL-PHONE USE (AND ANY OTHER DEVICE) FOR LATER. STUDENTS ARE ALLOWED TO USE CHROMEBOOKS AND CELL-PHONES OR OTHER DEVICES WHEN GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE TEACHER.

RETEACHING AND TUTORING

AS LEARNING A NEW LANGUAGE IS A DIFFICULT FEAT, STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SEEK OUT ADDITIONAL HELP AND REVIEW WHEN NEEDED. STUDIES SHOW THAT STUDENTS NEED TO SEE WORDS 7 TO 10 TIMES AND WAYS BEFORE STORING IT IN THEIR LONG-TERM MEMORY. THIS GOAL WILL BE STRIVED AFTER DURING CLASS BUT WILL BE MORE EASILY MET IF STUDENTS STUDY AND REVIEW ON THEIR OWN TIME OR WITH THE HELP OF A TEACHER. STUDENTS ARE MORE THAN WELCOME TO SET UP A TIME TO WORK ONE-ON-ONE OR IN A GROUP WITH THE TEACHER AFTER SCHOOL. AFTER SCHOOL IS A TIME DESIGNED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL HELP TO STUDENTS, IT IS REQUESTED THAT STUDENTS ONLY STAY AFTER SCHOOL IN THE SPANISH CLASSROOM IF THEY HAVE SPANISH WORK TO REVIEW OR COMPLETE.

PLAGIARISM AND TRANSLATING

PLAGIARISM OF SOMEONE ELSE'S WORK IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AND WILL RESULT IN AN AUTOMATIC ZERO IN THE GRADEBOOK.

Students are encouraged to utilize the textbook, paper copies of a Spanish-English dictionary, their teacher, or www.wordreference.com as resources instead.
